Timeline

Current Progress & Project Timeline

- ❖ Total # of referrals = 273
- ❖ Total # clients enrolled = 232 (85% enrollment rate)
- ❖ Total # of births to date = 83 births, 85 babies born (2 sets of twins)
- ❖ Total Medi-Cal clients= 165 (71%)
- ❖ Full term births (>37 weeks) = 91%
- ❖ Breastfeeding initiation = 84%
- ❖ 22 cesareans (26.5%)
- ❖ 65 positive perinatal mood and anxiety screenings (referrals made)
- ❖ 3 fetal losses (Miscarriage)
- ❖ Project goal of 360 clients with funding for the project set to run through Spring 2021

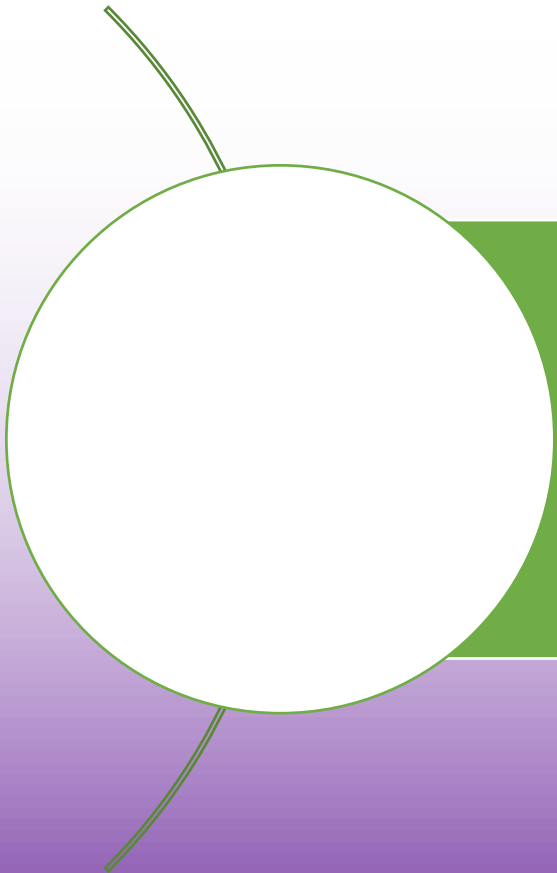

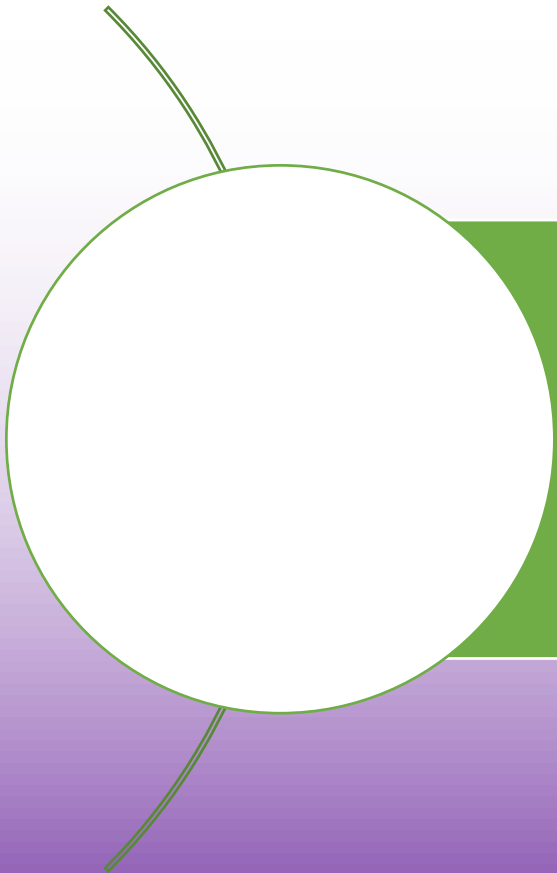

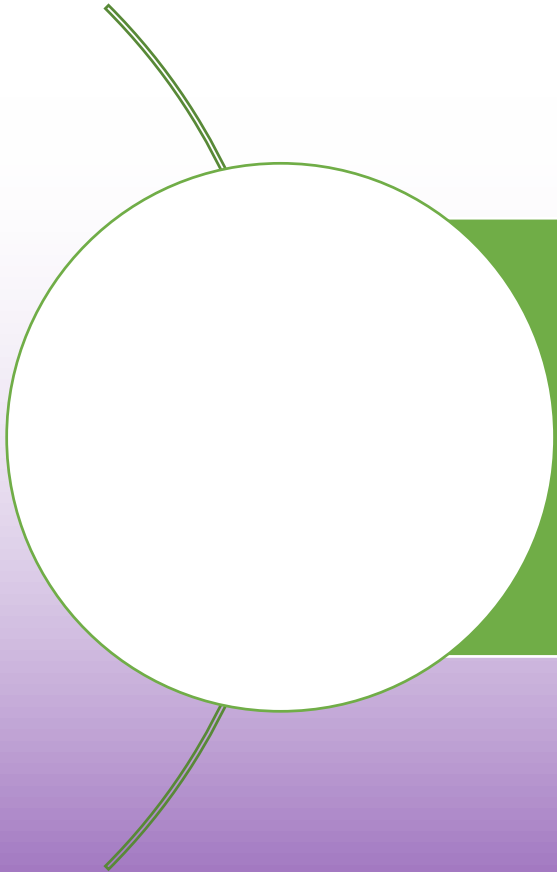
